Rural economic empowerment through access to reliable electricity

The Energy for Rural Start-Ups initiative, a partnership between Caritas Switzerland and Power-Blox AG, pioneers rural electrification in Ethiopia. Using Swiss-developed Powerblox (PBX) technology, it connects off-grid rural households with a nano-grid approach, empowers micro-enterprises, cooperatives, and public institutions. With a 100% payback rate in 10 months, it drives economic growth, resilience, and inclusion, aiming to scale up and electrify 100,000 households and empower 5,000 SMEs.

Our approach

Rural electrification with nano-grids Employing the adaptable Powerblox (PBX) swarm battery technology, we are revolutionizing access to reliable electricity in Ethiopia. By providing communities with this innovative solution, we are lighting up homes but also igniting economic empowerment for micro and small enterprises (MSEs), cooperatives, public institutions, and marginalized groups. This newfound access empowers them to enhance and broaden their business operations and services, while simultaneously playing a vital role in the electrification of rural households through the deployment of nano-grids.

Our technology

Swiss-developed **Powerblox PBX-200**

The Swiss-developed Powerblox PBX-200 is a swarm battery technology designed for rural off-grid energy solutions. A single PBX battery has a capacity of 200W AC and 1.3KWH, offering flexibility, speed, serviceability, cost-effectiveness, longevity, extendibility, upgradability, and integration pathways. The swarm grid concept provides infinite scalability, enabling tailored energy solutions for rural communities and businesses.
